**A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING RURAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS
AND ORDER TO ERECT REGULATORY SPEED SIGNS**

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. § 169.14, subd. 2(a) establishes a 35 m.p.h. speed limit on town roads in rural residential districts;

AND WHEREAS, a “rural residential district” is defined in Minn. Stat. § 169.011, subd. 69a, as “the territory contiguous to and including any ... town road that is built up with visible dwelling houses situated at intervals averaging less than 300 feet or less for a quarter mile or more.”;

AND WHEREAS, the town board has determined, as a result of on-site inspections, the following roads or road segments are within a rural residential district as defined above:

| 2. Devils Lake Road | From Jackim Trail to 460 th Street |
| 3. East Big McDonald Drive | From 0.8 miles south of CSAH No. 35 to cul-de-sac terminus. |
| 4. East Paul Lake Drive | From C.S.A.H. No. 34 to cul-de-sac terminus. |
| 5. Engstrom Beach Road | From 1.65 miles north of Mn Hwy 108 to cul-de-sac terminus |
| 6. Fawn Oaks Road | From Fawn Oaks Trail to cul-de-sac terminus |
| 7. North Big McDonald Drive | From North Big McDonald Lane to cul-de-sac terminus |
| 8. South Little McDonald Drive | From CSAH No. 34 to cul-de-sac terminus. |
| 9. North Little McDonald Drive | From West Little McDonald Drive to 455 th Street |
| 10. South Paul Lake Drive | From 430 th Street to cul-de-sac terminus. |
| 11. West Little McDonald Drive | From CSAH No. 35 to North Little McDonald Drive. |
| 12. West Paul Lake Drive | From CSAH No. 34 to cul-de-sac terminus.. |

AND WHEREAS, the Minnesota State Legislature has established the speed limit to be 35 m.p.h. for town roads within a rural residential district without the need for a speed study by the Minnesota Department of Transportation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the town board of Edna Township, Otter Tail County, Minnesota does hereby designate the above described roads or road segments that is built up with visible dwelling houses situated at intervals averaging less than 300 feet or less for a quarter mile or more as rural residential districts for the purposes of Minn. Stat. § 169.14, subd. 2(a);

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, by the town board of Edna Township, Otter Tail County, Minnesota that 35 m.p.h. regulatory speed limit signs be erected on the above described roads or road segments in accordance with the Minnesota Uniform Manual on Traffic Control Devices.
